March 26th / 27th 2013

Beyond Green Building - Green Communities.

The Conference took place on the 26-27th of March at the Monroe Hotel, and was held under the patronage of the Municipality of Beirut.

LGBC was a supporter to this event, and was offering a free ARZ registration at its booth in the exhibition and networking area. Many conference delegates were interested in the ARZ rating for commercial building and asked to receive ARZ soft copies or LGBC membership details. The booth was also considered as a gathering point for the new and old LGBC members.

International and local presenters addressed for the first time in Lebanon the subject of Eco-Cities and Green Communities with an in-depth review of Beirut City Green plan for soft transportation. The second day topics covered many case studies of Green buildings in Lebanon among which the first LEED Gold project in the Country, projects aiming for BREEAM, and projects bringing sustainability to remote rural communities.

- 2- They were given a worksheet having a picture for a house and had to identify and understand the source of the problem for indoor air quality including hazardous materials.
- 3- Students had to determine which area is the most polluted by counting the particles that will stick to a card over a period of time and compare the results by presenting a graph.

4- Animated slides showing the students different concepts for renewable energy.
5- Students were divided into groups & shared the information with all other students and representatives from different government agencies, and schools. The students asked questions, shared ideas & opinions, and learned new concepts regarding how to protect the environment.

The LGBC provided pamphlets and worksheets that the students kept for future reference.

The certificate given to every student who attended the LGBC workshop -brought them joy and pride.
